

Notifying the Public of Rights Under Title VI

- The Arc Nature Coast, Inc. operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, and national origin in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
- The Florida FLHSMV is committed to ensuring that no person is excluded from participation, denied benefits, or otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity, on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age, or disability, including income-level and LEP.
- The Department of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles as a recipient of federal financial assistance will ensure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, and related Nondiscrimination authorities in all FLHSMV programs and activities.
- Any person who believes that he or she has been subjected to discrimination or retaliation based on their race, color, national origin, sex, age, or disability, including income-level and LEP, may file a Title VI complaint. Complaints must be filed in writing and signed by the complainant or a representative and should include the complainants name, address, and telephone number or other means by which the complainant can be contacted. Complaints must be filed within 180 days of the date of the alleged discriminatory act.
